License or provincial registration that permits practice of psychotherapy or independent practice	(As at left) or: Background and training in mental health or related field. Not in independent practice. Employed in an institution or agency.
Malpractice Insurance	(As at left) or: Insurance through employer

CAST membership required. May attend CAST AGM, stand for Board	CAST membership required May attend CAST AGM, stand for Board

Total theoretical training hours: 100	Total theoretical training hours: 100
Total hours of Sandplay practice: 100	Total hours of Sandplay practice: 40
Two symbol papers	One theoretical paper including symbol work and analysis of client sandplay images
Total supervision hours: 100	Total supervision hours: 62 (50 hours before application – minimum 25 individual, 10 maximum with process therapist – and 12 individual hours during provisional year)

May practise in any setting	Practise in institution or agency only No independent practice (unless provincially licensed or registered & insured)
International recognition by ISST	National recognition by CAST only
May become Certified with ISST & CAST, ongoing memberships required	Status as Sandplay Practitioner granted by CAST, ongoing membership required
Level 5 may offer personal process on behalf of ISST/CAST	May not offer personal process
Level 6 may become an ISST/CAST certified teaching member	May not become a teaching member

Following achievement of Practitioner Status, the student may re-apply to complete Certification. Training and supervision hours completed while achieving Practitioner Status will be reviewed and recognised.
